Storage in the Slufter

For storage in depot the *Slufter* of contaminated dredged material originating from water bodies outside the Netherlands, an application that complies with the Acceptance Conditions of the Slufter is necessary. The application can only be accepted if the Port of Rotterdam Authority has granted its permission for storage.

An application request should include the following:

- A completed application form. A template can be downloaded from www.slufter.com;
- Results of the laboratory analysis of the samples, including the soil fractions. The analysis should contain the mandatory parameters stated on the *Slufter test form*. The laboratory analysis will be tested against the Dutch standards for disposal of contaminated sediments;
- A completed digital *Slufter test form*. This digital file will be provided by the *Slufter* or can be downloaded from www.slufter.com;
- An accompanying letter from the applicant, the disposer of the sediment;
- Historic survey/study for the (possible) presence of asbestos if the presence of asbestos is suspected;
- The total volume of contaminated sediments to be stored in the *Slufter*;
- Digital results of the laboratory analysis in *csv format;
- Map of the project location including the location of the samples;
- Survey of the sediment at the project location (in accordance to local standards).

The laboratory results of the analysis of the sediment samples will be tested against Dutch standards for storage of contaminated dredged material.

When the application request is complete and in accordance with the prevailing Acceptance Conditions and the Port of Rotterdam Authority has granted its permission, the application will be accepted. The Port of Rotterdam Authority will then provide a contract with a Dutch waste registration number. This registration number is necessary for the ex- and import permits for the contaminated dredged material.

Procedure for ex- and import

For transport of the sediment to the *Slufter* a notification is necessary in accordance with EU Regulation (EC) No. 1013/2006, to obtain the ex- and import permits.

Means of transport

Dredged material can be transported to the *Slufter* in three ways:

- Hopper dredger
- Barge (vessels)
- Truck
